

Career Education

Students at Yukon Public Schools have many opportunities to discover what post secondary options are available to them. Beginning in the 8th grade, enrollment counselors begin the process of helping each student realize future goals by using [EXPLORE Test \(http://www.act.org/explore/\)](http://www.act.org/explore/) results from tests given in the fall. Counselors, parents and students work together to develop a four year plan to help guide them through their high school careers. Further exploration is done through a freshman orientation class that all incoming freshman take, called [Keystone \(http://www.yukonps.com/Portals/0/docs/CDG%202010-11%20WEBSITE%20version%203-4-10.pdf\)](http://www.yukonps.com/Portals/0/docs/CDG%202010-11%20WEBSITE%20version%203-4-10.pdf). During the fall of the sophomore year all students take the [PLAN Test \(http://www.act.org/plan/\)](http://www.act.org/plan/). These results are shared with students during hourly sessions in conjunction with enrollment for the junior year. Students are encouraged to select courses that will further develop skills needed to prepare them for individual post secondary opportunities.

Career and Technology Education Programs

Yukon Public Schools boasts a strong curriculum for Career and Technology Education. CTE programs at YPS partner with the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education to deliver real world through "hands on" courses and experiences. Currently, YPS has twelve teachers who work to prepare students for life and the world of work.
