Yukon Public Schools Helping Hand Volunteer program assists teachers, schools and the community through the school district. We hope you feel welcome and enjoy your volunteer service. Helping Hands volunteer under the direction of the teacher, donating time and talent for our children and students. They enrich the curriculum and strengthen school and community relations. TEACHERS & STUDENTS NEED YOUR HELP. LISTED BELOW ARE AREAS YOU ARE NEEDED FOR VOLUNTEER SERVICE. ORIENTATION/ TRAINING IS PROVIDED:

- TUTOR** Under the direction of the teacher, working one on one with a child or small groups of students helping with reading, math and or spelling skills. **One to Two hours per week**
- CLERICAL** Copying papers, grading papers under the direction of a teacher and filing. Completing and coloring games and clerical work for a teacher. Also office volunteers. **One to Two hours per week**
- LIBRARY** Helping children find enjoyable books. Checking books and material in and out under the direction of the librarian. **One to Two hours per week**
- SHORT TERM** For volunteers who cannot commit to a special time but who would like to help with short volunteer term projects. Example: Vision and Hearing screening, P. E. Testing, Dolch word screening, resource person and field trip chaperones are needed.
- PUPPETEER** Perform educational curriculum script for students using "Kids on the Block Puppets." Assist counselors as they help children deal with social problems of today. **3 hours per week**
- MILLER MENTOR** Serve as a positive role model and provide tutoring and social support to help empower and motivate students to succeed. Work with individual students' approximately **30 minutes to an hour once or twice a week**.
- VISION & HEARING SCREENING** Check Pre-K through 8th grade student's vision & hearing at each school. You will be trained to use school vision or hearing testing equipment. **Must attend training. Short term, approximately 1 or 2 mornings or afternoons a week from Aug –Oct.**
- ART APPRECIATION** Share FUN information with one grade level, training provided. Learn the different classification of art Go with students and teachers to the OKC Museum of Art. Short duration, Museum trips and FUN!
- SERVICE SHELF** Help teachers in the building by running copies, using die cuts, and/ or coloring packets. **One to Two hours per week.**
- WATCHDOG DADS** Dads are invited to volunteer to spend time in their children's schools to help provide a safe environment & serve as positive male role models. **Trainings & Meetings to be announced**
